1. Council is asked to approve the purchase of the AVaiLWeb and Hardware Warranty for Vehicle Locator Services, as requested by the Columbia Police Department. Award to Utility Associates in the amount of \$73,738.08. The vendor is located in Decatur, GA.

Funding Source: Police Administrative Services - Maintenance & Service Contract (1012402-638200). The original budgeted amount is \$74,000.

2. Council is asked to approve a Professional Services sole source agreement for a consultant to provide a Municipal Complex Building Condition Report, as requested by the Support Services Division. Award to Pond & Company, as a Sole Source in the amount of \$90,235.00. Pond & Company's headquarters is located in Peachtree Corners, GA and the company maintains a local office in Columbia, SC.
