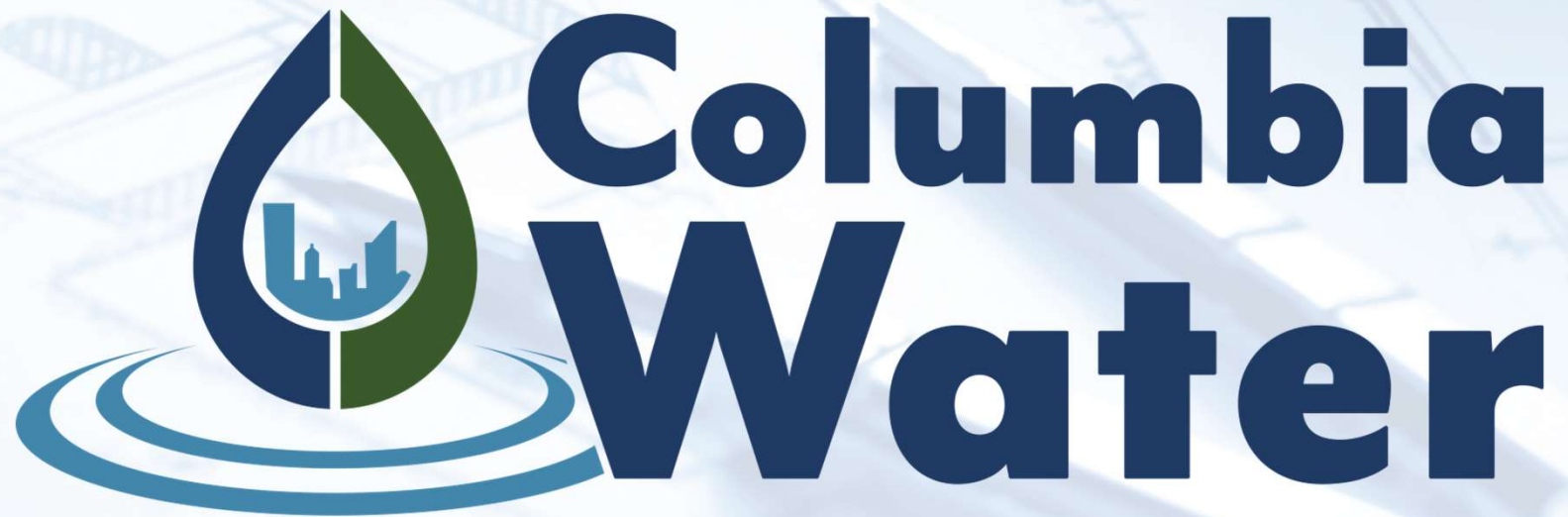

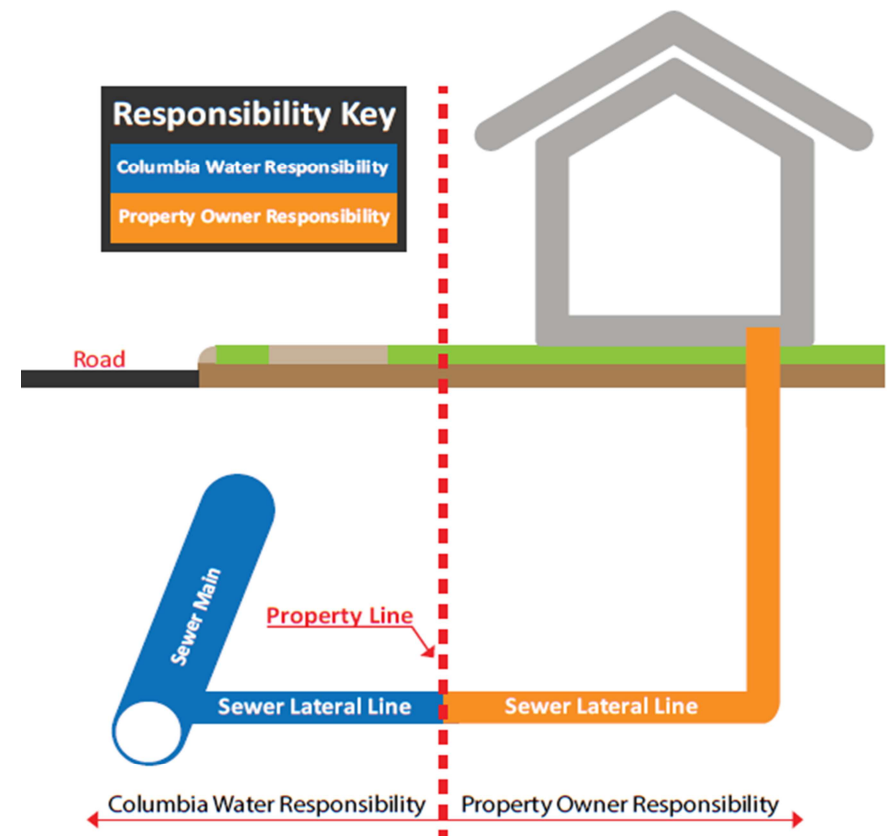

- Obligation to Notify Property Owners of Defective Sewer Laterals When Discovered
- Letter with City Brochure to be Sent
 - Requesting the owner make repairs

Sewer Lateral Responsibility

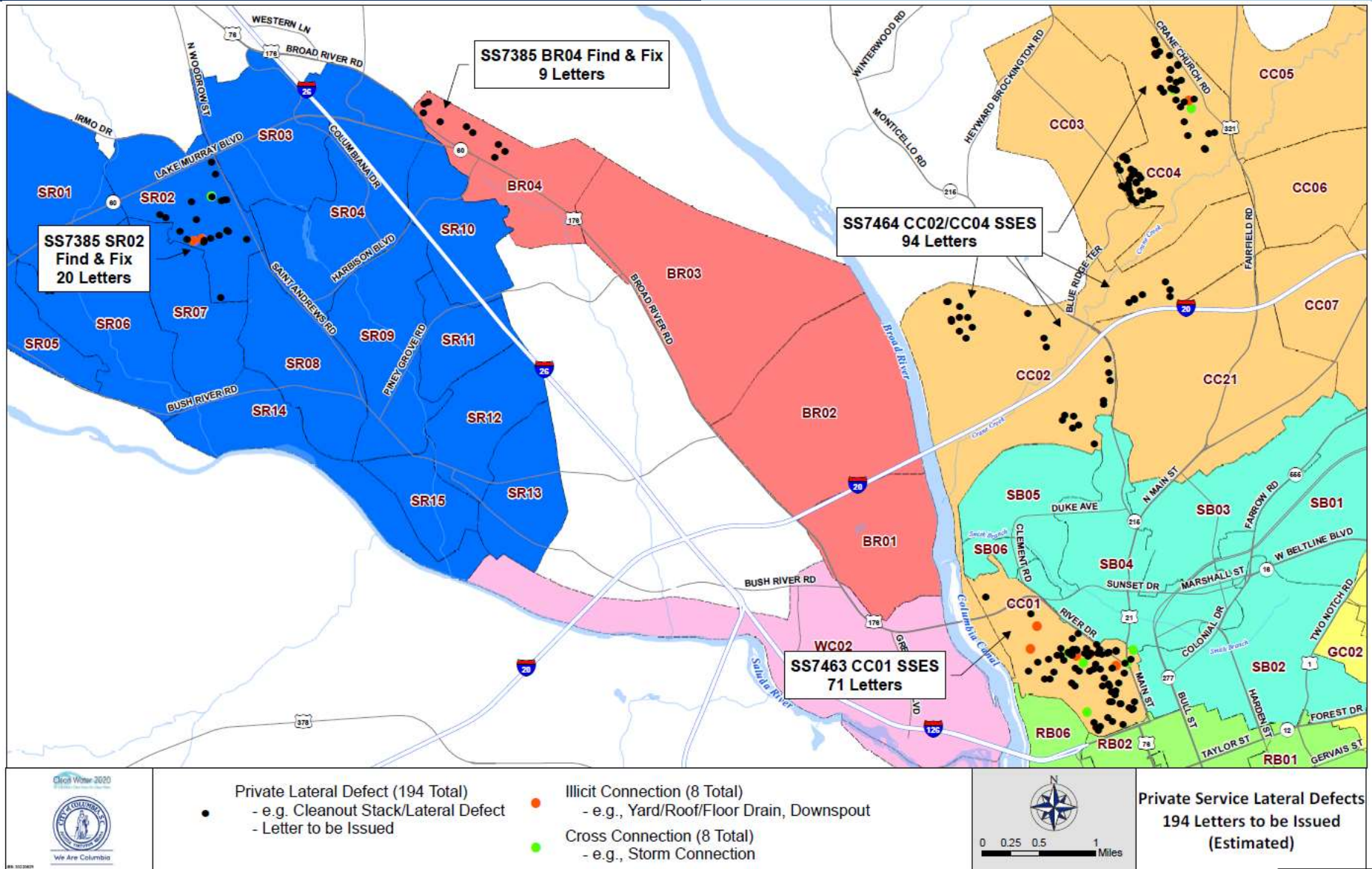


Defective Private Lateral Notifications

- Estimated 194 Notifications
- 3rd Round of Notifications
- Batch of Notifications to be Issued in Early November
 - Council will receive a sample letter package and notification

- 30-Day Public Notice Required
- Key Contents
 - Obligating the City to a significant number of sewer system rehabilitation and improvements
 - Obligation to complete within 5-years of approval
 - Focused on the minor system

Highlights of Work Completed To-Date

- Major Projects Completed for Two Chronic SSO Locations:
 - Crane Creek near I-20
 - Lake Katherine
- Proactive Start On:
 - IRR and SIRR projects
 - 11 complete, 27 ongoing
 - Capacity Enhancing projects
 - 3 complete, 13 ongoing
